- c.) M#17 Tress (change quarter not to eighth note) take breath on eighth rest, accent I
- d.) M#23 Crescendo to M#24
- e.) MEN-accent M#41-56

- a.) We will start on page 3
- b.) Please read as written
- c.) Tone-Senza vibrato

Modimo

a.) FUN- Watch Me—Yes, we will dance☺
