You will have the opportunity to hear our Young Adult Honors Choral Ensemble, comprised of 18-25-year-old musicians, in addition to two High School Honors Choirs.

The Honors Performance will be the concert of a lifetime! In order to ensure a positive experience for both performers and audience members, please review the following important concert notes:

- Intermission: There will be no intermission.
- <u>Cell Phones</u>: Please switch off your cell phones and other electronic devices. Refrain from texting or answering calls during the performance.
- <u>Recording Devices</u>: Taking photographs, audio recordings, and/or videos during the Honors Performance is <u>strictly prohibited</u>. Please note that Carnegie Hall ushers may confiscate any devices used in violation of this policy.
- Exiting the Hall: At the conclusion of the performance, please remain in your seat until all student performers have exited the Hall.
- Congratulating Your Finalist: Due to timing constraints in Carnegie Hall and with student transportation, Finalists must exit the Hall immediately following the performance. Those who wish to congratulate their Finalist
