- You will receive your Carnegie Hall and Metropolitan Museum of Art tickets upon program check-in.
- Tickets are distributed by family (Metropolitan Museum of Art and American Museum of Natural History tickets not included for Finalists). We do not have extras and cannot replace lost tickets.
- Please dress appropriately for the weather, including comfortable walking shoes, warm jackets, hats and gloves. New York City averages 27-40°F in February.
- To allow our Finalists to best prepare for their performance, rehearsals are closed. Family participants may sign-up to attend a Saturday rehearsal; you may sign up online (refer to your final update email or the Finalist Update Page) and at the Program Desk.
- The Sheraton Times Square is a large hotel and there can be a wait for the elevators. Please allow additional time when using the elevators.
- Finalists are not to leave the hotel unless escorted by an authorized adult. You must check your Finalist out from their Chaperone in person and set a time and location to rejoin the group.

- <u>Cell Phones</u>: Please switch off your cell phones and other electronic devices. Refrain from texting or answering calls during the performance.
- <u>Recording Devices</u>: Taking photographs, audio recordings, and/or videos during the Honors Performance is <u>strictly prohibited</u>. Please note that Carnegie Hall ushers may confiscate any devices used in violation of this policy.
- <u>Exiting the Hall</u>: At the conclusion of the performance, please remain in your seat until all student performers have exited the Hall.
- <u>Congratulating Your Finalist</u>: Due to timing constraints in Carnegie Hall and with student transportation, Finalists must exit the Hall immediately following the performance. Those who wish to congratulate their Finalist should return immediately to the designated ballroom at the Sheraton Times Square.

Performance concludes. Family participants may return to the Finalist hotel on foot or may board Series transportation at the front of the Hall.
