Family members, friends, and other supporters are welcome to participate with their student performers by electing one of the Honors Family Programs. These programs have been designed to enable supporters to stay in London with their Junior Finalist and attend select program events that are otherwise closed to non-performers (a rehearsal, London events, touring with Junior Finalists, Junior Finalist Celebration, etc.). Since most Honors Performance Series rehearsals are closed, there are other activities and free time included in the Family Programs to supplement your time.

The Family Program itineraries provide an opportunity to experience the best of the sights and culture in London. All itineraries are tentative and subject to change. Family Programs are offered only as full programs and cannot be sold as individual components. Please note: Transportation to/from London and meals are not included in the program.

Each family member wishing to register for a Family Program (excluding the Junior Finalist) must register separately. Junior Finalists should not register for the Family Program. They have been automatically registered for the Finalist program through the application and selection process.

### Royal Festival Hall Performance Tickets

One priority ticket to the Honors Performance is included with each Family Program registration. Seating is assigned and a special priority section is reserved for Family Program participants. Non-priority tickets can be purchased through the Royal Festival Hall Box Office in the spring. We are unable to accommodate requests for individually purchased tickets to be seated in the priority seating section.

## Program Costs and Available Payment Plans

The program cost for each family member participating in the 5-Day Family Program is \$1,825. The program cost for each family member participating in the 3-Day Family Program is \$975. Participants have the option to satisfy the full expense at once or may follow an optional payment plan; see <a href="www.honorsperformance.org/london-family">www.honorsperformance.org/london-family</a> to review the payment plan and the cancellation deadlines and penalties.

Looking for a way to prolong the fun of your family's Honors Performance Series experience? Our Sightseeing Extensions allow Junior Finalists and their loved ones to do just that! A licensed guide will be your host as you explore more of what London has to offer.

- August 1: Enjoy a full-day excursion into the countryside! Visit Stonehenge to decide for yourself how the enormous stones were arranged. Then explore the ancient Roman Baths and England's oldest holiday city, Bath.
- August 2: Dive deeper into the wonders of London! Enjoy a guided tour of Windsor Castle and visit St. George's Cathedral, two important locations for the Royal Family. See works of Michelangelo, Van Gogh, and Monet while exploring the National Gallery. And get a birds-eye view of the city from the London Eye ferris wheel.

The program cost for each Sightseeing Extension participant is \$825.
